### We'll Be So Busy!

**Math** - Students will learn how to use place value understanding to round multi-digit whole numbers to any place. They will take a test on Wednesday on Chapter 1 Place Value. In addition, students will learn how to add and subtract multi-digit whole numbers using the standard algorithm.

**Social Studies** - Students will learn about the first Americans, and the clothing, culture, location, and shelter of the Native American tribes in the US.

**Reading/ELA** - Students will reading informational text and learn how to find the main idea of a story. Also, we are learning how to identify text structures. In writing, we will be working on developing ideas and revising/editing our work.
