We'll Be So Busy!

Math- Students will use their mental computation and estimation strategies including rounding to solve multi- step word problems (addition and subtraction).

Social Studies - Students will continue to edit and finalize their song, rap, or poem about a Native American tribe. They will practice in class and at home. On Friday, students will take the Native American Test. Students should review their study guide, and go on the Native American Blendspace. They will perform their song, rap, or poem in class on September 5th.

Reading/ELA - Students will begin literacy centers with a focus on sequencing, synonyms, fairy tales, and making predictions. Students will begin working on writing narratives about small moments.

Science - We will start off the week with an assessment on Food Chains and Webs. Then, we will explore how a major event can affect the changes to the flow of energy in an ecosystem and predict the effects on a population if some of the animals become scarce, extinct, or overabundant.
