We will be having our first field trip for the semester to GA Aquarium on Thursday, October 19th! The permission slip and field trip money will be due on October 6th.

We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Please go on ConnectED to complete online assignments, and play review games. Students will use different strategies and methods to solve multiplication and division problems. In addition, students will learn how to find factors and multiples of whole numbers.

Social Studies - We will continue our unit on European explorers. Students will learn about Hudson, Balboa, Ponce de Leon, and Cabot, and match the causes and effects of the European explorers' explorations.

Reading/Writing - We will be focusing on expository text and find the multiple meaning words in the text. We will also be reinforcing the rereading strategy and comparing and contrasting information in passages.

Science - We will continue our unit on Force and Motion. Students will investigate gravity and how it affects the motion of a car rolling down a ramp. Students will investigate and identify balanced and unbalanced forces acting on an object. On Friday, students will be taking the Force and Motion test.
