### We'll Be So Busy!

**Math** - Students will continue to practice multiplying whole number of up to four digits by a one or two whole number using strategies based on place value and the properties of operations.

**Social Studies** - Students will learn about Chongqing's culture and will create a presentation about one aspect of Chongqing's culture based on their learning. They will present their project on Monday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. On Friday, students will take the Social Studies Interim District Assessment. Students should go on the class website and the Resources and Websites tab to review the different concepts and content taught in social studies.

**Reading/Writing** - Students will find main ideas and key details in persuasive passages. They will also practice finding subjects and predicates, and identifying run-on sentences. Students will continue adding sequence words and suffixes to their writings.

**Science** - Students will begin a new unit on the water cycle. They will learn to illustrate pathways water may take during the water cycle. They will see how heat energy affects water. Students should understand water cycles on Earth, and the cycle does not necessarily have a beginning or an end.
