We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will learn how to find whole number quotients and remainders with up to 4 digit dividends and 1digit divisors. Students will use place value understanding to round multi-digit numbers to any place.

Social Studies - Students will learn about the economy of the New England colonies, King Phillip's War, Middle Passage, triangular trade route, and the reason for the founding of the Middle or Mid-Atlantic colonies.

Reading/Writing - Students will read folktales and learn how to find the theme of a passage. They will also ask and answer questions about a passage to gain deeper understanding of the messages given. In writing, students will finish working on the organization of their sequencing writings and use proper and common nouns in the correct context.

Science - Students will continue to learn about the water cycle. They will be studying the four main processes and conducting experiments using the scientific method PHEOC. The water cycle assessment will be on Friday, October 27th. The study guide will be given out on Monday.
