We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will continue to practice how to find whole number quotients and remainders with up to four digit dividends and one digit divisors. Students will use the Distributive Property and partial quotients to divide and interpret what the remainder means in the context of a division problem.

Social Studies - We will continue our lesson on the 13 colonies. Students will learn about the advantages and disadvantages of being an apprentice, create a collage of Benjamin Franklin, learn about the founding fathers and leaders of the Southern colonies, and life in the Southern colonies.

Reading/Writing - Students will continue to read folktales and find the theme of a passage. They will also ask questions about a passage to gain a deeper understanding of the messages given. In writing, students will finish working on the organization in their narrative writings and use proper and common nouns in the correct context.

Science - We will begin a new unit on weather data and forecasting. The students will understand the difference between weather and climate. They will also be able to identify Earth's climate zones.
