We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will continue practicing and solving multi-step word problems using more than one operation and division problems that result in quotients that have zeros. Students will divide using different strategies, and check by multiplication and estimation. On Friday, students will take the Chapter 6 Division Cumulative Test.

Social Studies - Students will review the reasons settlers came to the New World and life in the 13 colonies in preparation for the test, create an advertisement for one of the 13 colonies, and create their own colony based on their knowledge about the 13 colonies. On Friday, students will take the 13 Colonies Test.

Reading/Writing - Students will continue using the Ask and Answer Questions Comprehension Strategy while reading drama passages. Students will also continue finding the key details to identify theme in reading passages. Students will be practicing identifying antonyms as a vocabulary strategy. The Unit 2 Week 2 test will be on Thursday.

Science - Students will continue studying the difference between weather and climate. They will identify the various weather instruments and how they are used to make forecasts. On Wednesday, they will take a quiz on weather and climate. The following Thursday, they will take a test on Weather Data and Forecasting.
