### We'll Be So Busy!

**Math** - Students will practice how to extend patterns and write observations about the pattern. Students will continue to practice how to write addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division equations using key words in word problems.

**Social Studies** - Students will explain the Tea Act, Boston Tea Party, Intolerable Acts, and importance of First and Second Continental Congress. They will explain the difference of a loyalist and patriot, and learn about the capture of Fort Ticonderoga and Battle of Bunker Hill.

**Reading/Writing** - Students will read expository text and find the main idea and key details of the texts. They will also summarize passages and use prefixes to gain a deeper understanding of the information given. In writing, students will be adding supporting details of their own.

**Science** - Students will begin a new unit on the Earth and Moon. They will discover the effects of the position and motion of Earth and the moon in relation to the sun as observed from the earth. They will also learn why the length of day and night change throughout the year.
