

Please remind your child the importance of completing their class assignments and homework assignments in a timely manner.

#### We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will learn how to compare two fractions with different numerators and denominators, by creating common denominators or numerators, or by comparing to a benchmark fraction. In addition, students will practice how to represent mixed numbers by decomposing them into a sum of whole numbers and unit fractions.

**Social Studies** - Students will review the key events of the Revolution, and the major battles of the war. On Wednesday, students will take the American Revolutionary War Test. On Thursday, students will take the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Midyear District Assessment. On Friday, students will begin their research on the geography or history of Chongqing.

Reading/Writing - Students will continue reading poems and learning about figurative language such as similes and metaphors. Students will also find the rhyme and meter of a poem and identify the meaning of them. In Writing, students will research to find information and facts about a topic they will do a writing piece on.

**Science** - This week we will be learning how seasons are caused by the earth's tilt and orbit around the sun. On Wednesday, we will be taking the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Midyear District Assessment. On Friday, students will be taking the Earth and Moon Science Test.
