### Monday, May 6, 2019

07:00 AM Hooray! You've arrived in Washington D.C.! Meet with your professional licensed tour guide at l'Enfant Plaza and get the show underway. The learning starts now :)

>>After your drivers drop you off at the Mall, they will be off duty for the day

>>Wear proper footwear! You'll be walking for a part of the evening

07:30 AM Refresh yourself and have breakfast! Enter the three-story glass gateway, take in the natural light and experience fine-dining at l'Enfant Plaza (at individual expense)

10:00 AM Begin your visit of the Smithsonian Institute with the exploration of the National Museum of African American History and Culture. Have lunch at one of the museum cafeterias (at individual expense)

01:00 PM Walk around the White House, the official residence and principal workplace of the President of the United States. Group photo time! No D.C. trip is complete without a snapshot of the whole squad in front of the White House. This would be the perfect time to bring that fancy camera of yours, or at least at selfie stick.

02:30 PM Time for a tour of the White House! (Requests must be submitted through one's Member of Congress up to six months in advance).

### Tuesday, May 7, 2019 (Cont.)

- 05:00 PM Meet back with your well-rested driver
- 05:30 PM Time for dinner and to explore in Georgetown, a place where history and modernity jell at their best. Spend some time on M street where you will find some of the city's top shops, tastiest restaurants and most luxurious hotels (at individual expense).
- 07:00 PM Say goodbye to your tour guide as you head to the hotel

### Wednesday, May 8, 2019

- 07:00 AM Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- 08:00 AM Everybody ready? Time to leave the hotel for your next activities!  
>Meet with your professional licensed tour guide at the entrance of Arlington Cemetery for a full day of activities.
- 09:00 AM The Arlington National Cemetery puts a lot of U.S. History into perspective. You'll see the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, a tribute to fallen unidentified American soldiers; there's also the Space Shuttle Challenger Memorial, an homage to the crew members killed aboard the ill-fated Challenger launch in 1986. You'll also see John F. Kennedy's gravesite. JFK is buried here and not in his native Brookline, MA, because Jacqueline Kennedy insisted that "he belongs to the people". Oh, and you won't want to miss the impressive changing of the guard.
- (There is the possibility of laying a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Please note that this must be arranged through your school.)

### Wednesday, May 8, 2019 (Cont.)

- 11:30 AM See the United States Marine Corps War Memorial inspired by the iconic photograph of six marines raising a U.S. flag atop Mount Suribachi during the Battle of Iwo Jima in World War II
- 12:30 PM Have lunch (at individual expense) at one of the 17 eateries of the Ronald Reagan Conference Center food court, featuring flavors from all around the world!
- 01:30 PM Visit the National Museum of American History, a Smithsonian highlight. Its wide range of exhibits and collections paints a vivid picture of U.S. history and pop culture, from the Star-Spangled Banner to Dorothy's ruby red shoes. There's even the forty-year-old Apple 1 Microcomputer, which by today's standards is anything but micro.
- 05:30 PM Enjoy the taste of Italy during your dinner at Bertucci's Italian restaurant in Washington DC.
- 07:00 PM Head out on a tour of the monuments with your tour guide. Meet the colossal Abraham Lincoln, be marvelled by the monument of World War II and take a moment in front of the Vietnam and Korean War Memorials
- 08:30 PM Say goodbye to your tour guide as you head to the hotel

- 10:00 AM George Washington built his estate on Mount Vernon, incorporating gardens and architectural features that made him into a reputed Virginia gentleman planter. Be amazed as you visit the home of the former leader of the United States of America.  
(Please arrive 30 minutes in advance to check in for your activity)
- 12:30 PM Lunch time! Choose among more than a dozen eateries at the National Place, “the hottest” food court in town (at individual expense)
- 02:00 PM Enjoy a self-guided visit of the National Air and Space Museum in Washington D.C. See the Spirit of St. Louis, in which Charles Lindbergh made the first solo flight over the Atlantic, the Bell X-1, which broke the sound barrier, COlumbia, the Apollo 11 spaceflight that landed the first two humans on the Moon, and so much more!
- 03:00 PM Time to check in for your visit of the US Capitol and meet up with your Congress representative.  
\*\*\*The Congress meet up is arranged through the school  
\*\*\*The program will be rearranged with the meet up confirmation
- 05:00 PM Union Station is a major D.C. commuter hub, serving over 5 million passengers a year! 30 years ago a section of the station was renovated to become a shopping mall and that’s where you’re having dinner tonight! We’ll give you dinner vouchers (included) for the food court; while you’re at it, your tour leader will give you time to squeeze in some souvenir shopping.
- 07:00 PM Begin the second part of the monuments tour with your tour guide, situated around the beautiful Tidal Basin. Visit the Jefferson Memorial to pay homage to the principal author of the Declaration of Independence, the larger-than-life Franklin Delano Roosevelt monument and stop by the Martin Luther King Memorial to see how world peace and nonviolent social change can be represented
- 08:30 PM Say goodbye to your tour guide as you head to the hotel

### Friday, May 10, 2019

- 06:00 AM      Begin your day with a lovely breakfast at the hotel.
- 07:00 AM      You won't believe it, but the time has come...for your last day of this fantastic journey! Time to leave the hotel with your luggage and take advantage of today to say goodbye to these foreign lands.  
Stops and meals en route (at individual expense).

## How much will it cost?

***\$650 US / 40 participants***

- The per student rate will fluctuate based on the number of paying participants traveling.
- As a rule, \$100 USD should be sufficient spending money for a 5 day “all inclusive” program, excluding clothes shopping or big ticket items.
- Jumpstreet highly recommends the RGP (Refund Guarantee Protection) plan to all students, as it allows them to cancel for any reason and receive a full refund (minus the cost of the plan) up to 48 hours prior to the trip’s departure. It also locks in the per student rate should a student with the RGP plan opt to cancel.

## What is included in the tour price?

We're glad you asked!

- **Roundtrip transportation** via luxury motor coach(es).
- **Complimentary chaperone** at a rate of 1 per 10 students (negotiable).
- **Hotel accommodations** as per your budget. Exact location confirmed upon receipt of a deposit.
- **Breakfasts and dinners**, as per the itinerary. All meals en route are at individual expense. (3 breakfasts, 2 dinners)
- **One tour leader** per motorcoach.
- **Admission to all services** as per the itinerary (includes tax and gratuities).
- Private group **night-time security** in the hotel.



## What is included in the tour price?

- Jumpstreet Tours maintains **25 million dollars** general liability insurance and **5 million dollars** Errors and Omissions (professional) liability insurance.  
(Transportation suppliers furnish their own liability insurance).
- **24 hour access** to Jumpstreet Headquarters while on tour.
- Jumpstreet **baggage tags and emergency lanyard with contact card.**
- Your money is placed in a **Bonded Trust account.**

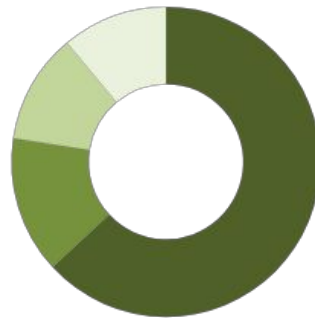

## Cost breakdown

- **The number of paying participants affects the per student rate for the trip.**
- The largest part of the overall cost is the motorcoach; the more paying participants per coach, the less expensive it becomes for everyone.
- When a student cancels at the last minute, causing a reduction in the overall numbers, this causes the per person rate to increase for the remaining students. Therefore, your deposit is only refundable if a replacement can be found.
