#### We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will practice how to extend patterns and write observations about the pattern. Students will continue to practice how to write addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division equations using key words in word problems.

Social Studies - Students will learn the elements of a personal budget. The meaning of income, expenditures, savings, personal spending, and practice saving decisions. The Economics test will be on Friday, November 30th.

Language Arts - In reading, students will compare firsthand and secondhand accounts, and cite evidence from the text. In grammar, students will identify the simple subject and predicate in a sentence. In writing, students will finalize their magazines design and share with their classmates their mini-magazine.

Science - Students will continue to learn about tools such as thermometers, rain gauges, wind vanes, barometers, and anemometers can be used to gather weather data. Patterns can be observed in weather data and can be used to make predictions about future weather. Weather describes the conditions outside at a certain place and time while climate describes the general conditions over a long period of time. The Weather and Climate test will be on Friday, November 30th.
