We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will continue to practice how to write addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division equations using key words in word problems. Students will learn how to explain why a fraction is equivalent to a fraction by using visual fraction models.

Social Studies - Students will work on their presentation about the geography or history of Chongqing. Students should practice their presentation to the class.

Language Arts - In reading, students will determine the author's point of view, and identify synonyms and antonyms. Students will also learn to identify evidence supporting the author's point or reason for writing the text. In grammar, students will identify if a sentence is a simple or compound sentence. In writing, students will write a fairy tale in the perspective of a different character similar to the fractured fairy tales.

Science - Students will learn about the effects of the position and motion of Earth, and the moon in relation to the sun as observed from Earth.
