We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will learn how to use the four operations to solve word problems involving distances, intervals of time, liquid volumes, and money including problems involving simple fractions or decimals, and problems that require expressing measurements given in a larger unit in terms of a smaller unit.

Social Studies - Students will continue learning themes and concepts regarding abolition and suffrage movements. They will study the contributions and challenges faced by Susan B. Anthony, Frederick Douglass, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Sojourner Truth, and Harriet Tubman.

Language Arts - In reading, students will identify information within texts on the same topic and integrate information from two texts on the same topic. In grammar, students will identify and write comparative adjectives. In writing, students will select a topic for their informational writing piece and begin their research on the selected topic. They will utilize the strategies learned in reading to apply for their writing.

Science - Students will learn that light is a type of energy and will travel in a straight line. Reflection of light is when the light bounces off an object back towards the light source. Refraction of light is when the light bends as it passes through an object.
