We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will learn how to add and subtract multi-digit numbers, use mental math to add and subtract, estimate sums and differences, and solve multi-step word problems.

Social Studies - Students will continue to learn the causes of the American revolution.

Language Arts - In reading, students will continue to use text evidence to support their ideas about the main character in their independent reading book. They will learn to debate and argue by context for their ideas and select evidence to persuade the other person. In writing, students will begin to draft their narrative writing piece. For grammar, students will learn to use commas in a series in a sentence. Students will also need to be able to identify the complete subject and complete predicate in a sentence.

Science - Students will learn how changes affect ecosystems. They will be able to model how the introduction or removal of organisms affects the stability of an ecosystem.
