We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will practice how to illustrate and explain multiplication problems by using equations and rectangular arrays.

Social Studies - In social studies, students will learn about the key figures that influenced the American Revolution and review for the American Revolution test. They will review the causes, the major events, and key influential people.

Language Arts - In reading, students will continue to work on identifying the theme in the story by identifying the problems the character faced and thinking about what lesson does the character learn to be applied to the world. In writing, students will read one another's narrative, and create writing goals for themselves. For grammar, students will practice writing comparative (-er) and superlative adjectives (-est). Friday's quiz will require students to also identify the simple subject and simple predicate.

Science - In science, students will investigate how simple machines reduce the amount of force needed to do work. They will use these words when explaining simple machines: work, simple machine, load, wheel and axle, and inclined plane.
