### We'll Be So Busy!

**Math** - Students will learn how to find whole number quotients and remainders with up to four digit dividends and one digit divisor.

**Social Studies** - This week, students will describe the structure of government and the Bill of Rights. They will learn how the three branches of government interact with each other (checks and balances and separation of powers) and how they relate to local, state, and federal government.

**Language Arts** - On Tuesday, students will take the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester ELA Interim District Assessment. Students will learn to identify the nonfiction text structures: description, compare and contrast, chronological, problem and solution, and cause and effect. They will use the knowledge of the structure to help them understand the main idea and details of the text. In writing, students will write an on-demand personal narrative, and then they will learn how to write an opinion essay. There will not be a grammar quiz this week.

**Science** - This week, students will begin a new unit on The Water Cycle. They will describe the three states of water by recording observations in each of its phases.
