They should go on IXL to practice language arts and math skills.

We'll Be So Busy!

Math - Students will practice how to display measurement data in line plot and record measurement equivalents in a two- column table.

Social Studies - In social studies, students learn about the hardships on the Oregon Trail, the impact of the Gold Rush, and the impact of the Industrial Revolution on Westward Expansion.

Language Arts - In reading, students will read an informational text about Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and Rosa Parks. They will also read an informational text learning about Chinese New Year. They will to synthesize information about a subtopic they have been reading and researching. In grammar, students will practice punctuating dialogue, identifying the adjectives and adverbs, and writing a vivid verb for a sentence. In writing, students will decide the text structure they are going to use for their informational book.

Science - In science, students will investigate the physical properties of the inner planets.
