Math - Students will practice how to use the four operations to solve world problems involving distances, liquid volumes and

Social Studies - In social studies, students will take the Westward Expansion Test on Wednesday. February 12. Then, they will review concepts learned previously in the year.

Language Arts - In reading, students will practice debating their position in preparation for Tuesday's in-class Second Continental Congress. On Wednesday, students will take a reading comprehension test. They will need to know how to identify main idea and text evidence supporting it, determine the meaning of words based on context clues, and determine the author's point of view. In writing, students will finalize their writings and create a cover for their informational book and celebrate their accomplishments.

Science - In science, students will obtain, evaluate, and communicate information about the nature of light and how light interacts with objects. The Light Test will be held on Friday, February 28.
